REVEALED: The Blue Fault, 47 seats where tactical voting can push the Conservatives into third place

Data compiled by <u>StopTheTories.vote</u> and <u>TacticalVote.co.uk</u> shows the 47 most marginal seats where tactical voting can push the Tories into 3rd place nationally behind the Liberal Democrats described as "The Blue Fault" effectively pushing them out of both government and official Opposition.

The Conservatives only have a small lead in the following list of 47 seats. If these seats are lost to Labour, the SNP and the Liberal Democrats they would fall into 3rd place.

Carol Vorderman from StopTheTories.vote says:

"In this election many people are already planning to vote tactically and the polls reflect a lot of that with the Tories already set to lose many seats. But we have identified the key seats where the outcome still hangs in the balance. A small push in these locations would be enough to leave the Liberal Democrats with a higher number of seats than the Conservatives."

Becky Snowden from TacticalVote.co.uk says:

"In parliament, the Opposition's role is to scrutinise and question the Government. We don't think the Tories should be in this position of power after everything they've done over the last 14 years. We don't just want to stop them leading the government; we want to strip them of as much power as possible. We believe the Liberal Democrats will be a much better Opposition. An Opposition who for example pushes to introduce proportional representation so that everyone's votes count instead of pushing to allow water companies to dump sewage in our rivers."
